



Reap the Rewards



YEAR 2-6 INCENTIVE SCHEME 2018

Falcon Primary School is proud of its outstanding reputation in the community. As a reward for consistent good behaviour in the classroom and the playground we would like to offer students in Years 2 to 6 the privilege of attending a social excursion/activity at the end of each term. Any student who doesn't accumulate 5 demerit points *in a term* will be invited to attend the special activity.

As an added incentive to recognise positive behaviour, all students who haven't received a demerit during the first 5 weeks of each term will be included in a checkpoint reward draw for special prizes.

The following information and guidelines are provided for teachers, students and parents and are applied in conjunction with the Falcon Primary School Negative Consequences Chart.

- ⇒ **Minor classroom and playground offences** (actioned by class teachers) = **0 demerit**
These include warnings, playground restrictions, classroom consequences, blue dot, buddy class, Thinksheet and isolation in class or the block.

LEVEL 1

- ⇒ **Breach of school or classroom rules** (actioned by class teachers or Assistant Principals) = **1 demerit**
These include inappropriate playground behaviour, physical intimidation, bullying, withdrawal from classroom, inappropriate language, and not following instructions. Also repeated instances of minor offences such as no hat outdoors, running on verandahs, calling out, incomplete class tasks, play fighting and name calling. At this point a red dot may also be given at the discretion of the Assistant Principal.

LEVEL 2 (actioned by Assistant Principals)

- ⇒ **Detention** = **2 demerits**
Includes behaviour considered to be of a more serious nature such as fighting, disrespecting adults, abusive language and defacing school property or continual breaches of school rules.

LEVEL 3 (actioned by Principal and Assistant Principal in consultation) = 3 demerits

- ⇒ **In-school suspension** Withdrawal from the class program and separate recess and lunch.

LEVEL 4 (actioned by Principal) = 5 demerits

- ⇒ **Suspension** Automatic exclusion from school and rewards.

A record of behaviour infringements is maintained and parents are informed either through the student diary or formal notification. Students in Year 6 who consistently demonstrate misbehaviour may be excluded from camp. Parents will be contacted by the school when a student has accumulated 3 demerits in a term (an IBP is developed) or is at risk of being excluded from excursions or camp. If a student accumulates 5 demerits in a term, a conference involving a parent, teacher and administrator is required. The privilege of representing the school through interschool sport or other out of school activities is dependent on consistent good behaviour. The Assistant Principals will consult with teachers and the Principal regarding eligibility of students for such activities.

This REWARD SYSTEM is one of many in place at Falcon PS. We encourage students to work and behave positively and consistently well to be eligible for a range of rewards. These may include; raffle tickets and Gotcha cards for the Faction Points Competition, Honour Certificates, Aussie of the Month Awards, Principal Awards, Postcards from Falcon, Canteen ice-cream and icy pole vouchers, special prize draws and individual classroom rewards.

Parents and students are asked to read this information together and sign the attached Behaviour Agreement before returning it to the class teacher. We look forward to a rewarding school year in 2018.
