Minimum reporting requirements and guidelines

The following table includes prescribed minimum reporting requirements and guidelines for the learning areas taught in Pre-primary to Year 10 **2, 3** in Western Australian schools. Schools should report twice a year on a student's achievement in English, Mathematics, Science and Health and Physical Education. For the remaining learning areas schools should report twice a year if the learning area is taught over a year and once a year for learning areas taught over a term or semester.

Learning areas	Reporting requirements^{2,3}	Guidance (not mandated)
English	Schools will report one grade (A–E) as a minimum for English.	Schools may choose to report at a more detailed level using, for example, the modes of Reading and Viewing, Writing, Speaking and Listening.
Mathematics	Schools will report one grade (A–E) as a minimum for Mathematics.	Schools may choose to report at a more detailed level, for example, Number and Algebra, Measurement and Geometry, Statistics and Probability.
Science Biological Sciences; Chemical Sciences; Earth and Space Sciences; Physical Sciences	Schools will report one grade (A–E) as a minimum for Science.	Schools may choose to report at a more detailed level, for example, Science Understanding, Science Inquiry Skills and Science as a Human Endeavour or, in the secondary years, Biological Sciences, Chemical Sciences, Earth and Space Sciences, Physical Sciences.
Humanities and Social Sciences Civics and Citizenship; Economics and Business; Geography; History	Schools will report one grade (A–E) as a minimum for Humanities and Social Sciences.	Schools may choose to report to parents at a more detailed level, for example, Civics and Citizenship, Economics and Business, Geography, History.
Languages	Schools will report one grade (A–E) as a minimum for the language(s) taught.	Schools may choose to report at a more detailed level using, for example, Communicating, Understanding.
The Arts Dance; Drama; Media Arts; Music; Visual Arts	Schools will report one grade (A–E) as a minimum in The Arts.	Schools may choose to report at a more detailed level, for example, Dance, Drama, Media Arts, Music, Visual Arts.
Health and Physical Education	Schools will report one grade (A–E) as a minimum for Health and PE	Schools may choose to report at a more detailed level, for example, Health, Physical Education.
Technologies Design and Technology; Digital Technologies	Schools will report one grade (A–E) as a minimum for Technologies.	Schools may choose to report at a more detailed level, for example, Design and Technology, Digital Technologies
